

# Walking the Divine Path With the Divine Guide, Down the Journey of Life.

This morning the Lord Himself has a pathway for our lives.

That pathway is in His Word.

This morning consider your self invited by the Lord God Himself to be Walking the Divine Path  
With the Divine Guide, Down the Journey of Life.

The question in our minds is always – HOW? So this morning listen to God's Word and learn how to be Walking the Divine Path With the Divine Guide, Down the Journey of Life.

When Paul wrote to a church he had never visited – what was his message?

When Paul wished to disciple and nurture a group of far away saints he never would get to know face to face – what did he tell them to do?

When Paul saw his ability to get around limited by prison – what was he encouraging others to do?

To find out, turn with me to the 3<sup>rd</sup> of his four epistles written from prison – Colossians 3.16-17.

- What was Paul's answer to spiritual warfare? "The sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God".
- What was Paul's method for personal nurture and growth in those he disciplined? "Let the Word of Christ richly dwell in you."
- What was Paul's last word on doctrine, reproof, and correction? "All Scripture!"

So this morning what do we need to help us live a life that matters?  
What do we need to make it in this world?  
What will maximize the well done of Christ some day?  
How can we accomplish what He has called us to do?

Colossians 3.16-17 says it all – LET THE WORD OVERFLOW YOUR LIFE. That is what we have been called the Word filled life.

Pray.

To explain the Word filled life we have been studying Psalm 119.

Psalm 119 is a Psalm or song written by God to summarize the power and purpose of His Word. Longer than all but three of Paul's epistles – we have a book within a book, by the Author of the Book about the Book of Books!

Psalm 119 is a call by the Lord to each of us – to unleash His Word into our lives today.

As we open to the 119<sup>th</sup> Psalm this morning, we open to the greatest commentary ever written on the Bible.

Woven into the 119<sup>th</sup> Psalm we find 10 amazing words. These are words that God chose to describe His Word – the Bible.

Each of these words<sup>1</sup> is a picture. Each portrays a different facet of what the Lord wants to do in each of our lives this morning if we allow Him to.

**PRECEPTS: *When His Word is filling our lives we are***  
Following the **Divine Directions** for Life that are right and cause great rejoicing. (21x)

- Have you ever tried to put a bike or wagon together without the directions? How about a desk or a lawn mower? It is hard – but what about the directions for life, for marriage, for parenting, for business... where are they? Right here.
- Psalm 119:4, 15 You have commanded us To keep Your precepts diligently. 15 I will meditate on Your precepts, And contemplate Your ways. 27 Make me understand the way of Your precepts; So shall I meditate on Your wonderful works. 40 Behold, I long for Your precepts; Revive me in Your righteousness.

1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>WAY: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Walking the <b>Divine Path</b> with the Divine Guide, down the Journey of Life. (13x)</li> <li>▪ Our family went to Mammoth Cave one year. It was beautiful, but at the end as they always do – they had us sit and then turned out the lights. Then the guide said, you are 140 feet underground. It is 14 stories of solid rock above you, there is no light for <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> of a mile of winding, wet, dangerous passageways – do you need a guide? YES we all said. Do you see life that way? Without the divine guide of the Word, of Jesus walking us through life – it is even more hopeless than that cave.</li> <li>▪ Psalm 119: 1, 3, 5, 14 Blessed are the undefiled in the way, Who walk in the law of the Lord! 3 They also do no iniquity; They walk in His ways. 5 Oh, that my ways were directed To keep Your statutes! 14 I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, As much as in all riches.</li> </ul>
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>TESTIMONIES: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Listening to the <b>Divine Witness</b> testifying to the Truth that is sure &amp; makes wise. (23x)</li> <li>▪ There is only person that knows your future. There is only one map that leads to the right destination. There is only one witness that will always tell you the truth about your origin, your purpose, and your destiny. And that One is here and His record is in this book – God's Word !</li> <li>▪ Psalm 119:2 Blessed are those who keep His testimonies, Who seek Him with the whole heart! 24 Your testimonies also are my delight And my counselors. 46 I will speak of Your testimonies also before kings, And will not be ashamed. 59 I thought about my ways, And turned my feet to Your testimonies.</li> </ul>

5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>WORD: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Reading the <b>Divine Word</b> to obtain the Will of God. (19x)</li> <li>Psalm 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You. 38 Establish Your word to Your servant, Who is devoted to fearing You. 41 Let Your mercies come also to me, O Lord— Your salvation according to Your word.</li> </ul>
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>LAW: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Receiving <b>Divine Instructions</b> from the Ultimate Teacher giving Perfect Instructions that restores &amp; transforms (Congo) (25x)</li> <li>Psalm 119:1 Blessed <i>are</i> the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD. 18 Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous things from Your law. 34 Give me understanding, and I shall keep Your law; Indeed, I shall observe it with my whole heart. 44 So shall I keep Your law continually, Forever and ever.</li> </ul>
7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>JUDGMENTS: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Building Life upon the Unchanging Decrees of God's <b>Divine Decisions</b> that are always true &amp; vindicates. (23x)</li> <li>(Wm. Borden) changing jobs, changing weather, upgrading, latest edition, newest version...</li> </ul>
8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>RIGHTEOUS: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Acting upon the <b>Divine Righteousness</b> that Balances all of Life. (12x)</li> </ul>
9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>STATUTES: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Using the <b>Divine Plans</b> or specs to build the Ultimate Life. (22x)</li> <li>Isaiah 30:21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," Whenever you turn to the right hand Or whenever you turn to the left.</li> </ul>

- UNLEASHES RIGHT LIVING: 40 Behold, I long for Your precepts; **Revive me in Your righteousness**.

## APPENDIX

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| 11 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>FEAR: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Practicing the <b>Divine Condition</b> of Fearing God that makes life clean &amp; enduring (Bema) (3373) Divine Condition that is clean and endures forever. (dried onions not zapped grew army words/moths). <u>HIS CLEAN FEAR ENDURES</u> (v. 9a 3373 <i>The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever</i>) = The Word of God is the Divine Conditions (eternal life) THE DIVINE CONDITION. This is fearing God, lovingly acknowledging by my actions God sees me. <b>Enduring forever.</b> Filth brings decay, but cleanness is the great foe of corruption. The grace of God in the heart being a pure principle is also an abiding and incorruptible principle, which may be crushed for a time, but cannot be utterly destroyed. it will cleanse our way, Ps. 119:9. And it <i>endureth for ever</i>; it is of perpetual obligation and can never be repealed. The ceremonial law is long since done away, but the law concerning the fear of God is ever the same. Time will not alter the nature of moral good and evil. <b>The fear of the Lord]</b> <i>yirah</i>, from <i>yara</i>, to <i>fear</i>, to <i>venerate</i>; often put for the whole of Divine worship. The reverence we owe to the Supreme Being. Is <b>clean]</b> <i>tehorah</i>, from <i>tahar</i>, to be <i>pure, clean</i>; not differing much from <i>barah</i>, to be <i>clean and bright</i> as the <i>heavens</i>; as purified SILVER. Its object is to purge away all <i>defilement</i>, to make a <i>spotless character</i>. <b>Enduring for ever]</b> <i>omedeth laad, standing up to</i> PERPETUITY. The <i>fear</i> that prevents us from offending God, that causes us to <i>reverence</i> him, and is the <i>beginning</i> as it is the safeguard of <i>wisdom</i>, must be carried all through life. No soul is safe for a moment without it. It prevents departure from God, and keeps that clean which God has purified. This is ITS <i>use</i>. FEAR tells of the settled habit of the soul which is informed by the LAW. CLEAN, with no foul spot, antagonizing corruption; It ENDURES forever; the Word is eternal</li> </ul> |
| 12 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>TRUTH: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Believing the <b>Divine Truth</b> from God that stabilizes all of life. (530) <i>EMUNAH</i>, from <i>aman</i>, to <i>make steady, constant</i>, to <i>settle, trust, believe</i>. In Psalm 119 this word occurs in v. 30; 75; 86; 90; 138. The <i>law</i> that is established steady, confirmed, and ordered in all things, and sure; which should be <i>believed</i> on the authority of God, and <i>trusted</i> to as an infallible <i>testimony</i> from Him who cannot <i>lie</i> nor deceive.</li> </ul>  |

	<p>FAITHFULNESS, EMUNAH: nor does it appear in Ps 119:90, where it occurs, to be used as a characteristic of God's <i>law</i>, but rather his exact fulfilment of his <i>promises</i> to man. BELIEVING THE TRUTH</p>
13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>NAME: <i>When His Word is filling our lives we are</i></b> Honoring the <b>Divine Revelation</b> from the Creator of the Universe. (8034) <i>shem</i>, see Ps 119:132: but this is no characteristic of God's law; it refers here simply to himself. <i>Those that love thy</i> NAME is the same as <i>those that love</i> THEE. Bishop <i>Nicholson</i> inserts <i>promises</i> among the <i>ten</i> words: but this occurs no where in the Psalm. LIVING THE NAME – SONS OF GOD; CHRISTIANS</li> </ul>
