- 2*. What can we learn about Ahab from the fact that Obadiah speaks three times of his fear that he will be killed by Ahab (vv. 9, 12, 14)?
3. What are the two possible reasons why Ahab searched for Elijah in every nation and kingdom?
4. Why would Obadiah have thought that the Spirit of the LORD would possibly carry Elijah to an unknown location?
5. Why does Elijah swear by the LORD of *hosts* (v. 15)?
6. How does Ahab demonstrate again his complete lack of repentance?
7. Why is it remarkable that Elijah accuses Ahab and the people of Israel that they have followed *Baalim* (not: Baal)?
8. Why did Elijah command Ahab to gather all Israel *at Mount Carmel*?
