Revelation 4

The sermon referenced the “transparency” in heaven as depicted by the “sea of glass” “clear as crystal”. Why is transparency so difficult for people today and how important is it to maturing as a man or a woman?

2. The “sea of glass” reflects God’s glory. Read Titus chapter 2. Are you, as a woman reflecting maturity, modesty, reverence before your daughters? If not, what can you do? Do you as a woman need a mature woman of faith in your life? Do you want one? If not, why?

5. Last week you were encouraged to lay prostrate before the Lord not unlike the Apostle John. What was that like? If you chose not to do so—why? If you didn’t know about it—what about this week? Check it out for a few mornings! Talk about your experience or your choice not to do it.
