5) Miswa (commandment) (22); emphasizes not only the clear commands but also the direct authority and the right of the one giving them (missile codes); Gen 2:16; expresses the insistent will of both a Lord & Savior. Not burdensome.

8) Imra (word, promise, command)(19); a declaration written or verbal made by one person to another, which binds the person who makes it, either in honor, conscience, or law to do what was promised; a declaration which gives to the person to whom it was made the right to expect it. Promises from God to those that are His. They are personal and beneficial, reminding us of the purity, comfort, support, security, deliverance, sweetness and salvation of God's word.
