John 6:28,29 WHAT GOD REQUIRES

The Bible asks vital questions, this is one! Here is another from Job? "How can a man be <u>in the right</u> before God?"[Job 9:2]. Micah asks "...what does the Lord <u>require</u> of you?"[Mic 6:8]! I was really fascinated with what I read about **Leo Tolstoy**! He was a world famous novelist with wealth and riches and fame. But he was **concerned** about **these** questions!!

GOD DEMANDS

For Tolstoy, God demanded 100% perfection – and he tried with all his heart to reach that! But he didn't manage! His friends had to hide all the ropes/guns around his home to **prevent** him from the temptation to commit **suicide**. He had a wonderful ambition – to reach **God's** Ideal! To reach what the Bible & Christ's <u>Sermon on the Mount</u> taught! [<u>Read Dens</u> <u>Digest, pages 2,3 marked</u>]. "What shall we do that we may work the works of God?"! <u>APP</u> Are you/I as concerned as Tolstoy was about such an important subject?

What's the **answer** to Tolstoy's great **dilemma**? "Who then can be saved?" The **next verse** of our **text** gives us the answer! "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent"! Isn't that **music** to your ears? Tolstoy knew **nothing** of Christ's **pardon** and **forgiveness**. It wasn't in his vocabulary! Tolstoy knew about God's <u>Law</u> – he feared the Law of God, but knew nothing of His pardon – he **knew nothing** of this verse "and this is His commandment: that you should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ" [1J3:23]. The Philippian Jailor was in terror "What must I do to be saved?" = "believe on the L J C...be saved"! + "a righteousness from God apart from law is revealed...even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ to all and for <u>all who believe</u>" [Rom 3:21] + "a man is **not justified** by observing the **law** but by **faith** in

Jesus Christ" [Gal 2:16]! The answer is not in 'doing' but in 'believing' (ie, trusting) having **faith** in Jesus.

So what about the **law** that God seems so 'fussy' about? After we believe, can we just live as we like? No, no. The law **does** have to be **kept** - but note the **two things Tolstoy never understood**! For all his reading of the NT, he never understood:-

- (a) the law is kept on our behalf by Jesus Christ if we are believers in Him! God did not waive His law (because it is important to Him). Christ kept the law on behalf of those who believe in Him. "God demonstrates His own love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us" [R5:8] God "did not spare His own Son but delivered Him up for us (believers) all" [R8:32] "Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us" [1C5:7] "God made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us" [2C5:21]! "Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law being made a curse for us" [Gal 3:13]! Tolstoy never realized Christ died on the behalf of sinners who believed in Jesus! *Second Tolstoy never knew...
- (b) "Love is the fulfilling of the law" [Rom 13:10b] "all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: you shall love your neighbour as yourself" [Gal 5:14] + "If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbour as yourself," you do well" [Jam 2:8]. If we are true believers in Christ there's one thing that will happen to us we will love God AND people more than anything else more than your car, house! What is the greatest commandment in the law? Jesus replied 'To love God' and added for our benefit 'The next is like it 'To love your neighbour'! It seems Jesus really wanted us to 'get' this point for He added as if it was too important to be left out "On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets" [Mat 22:36-40]!

Love for God and people is the one outstanding characteristic of true believers! Look: "A new command I give you Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another" [John 13:35]! This is the mark and sign that you are 'born again'! True Xians are identified, not by their love of doctrinal beliefs, but by their love for other Xians! "We know that we have passed from death to life because we love the brothers" [1J3:14]. That might be hard but it is what we're called to! We must love Xians with whom we disagree!

True faith in Jesus Christ manifests itself! You can't have faith without 'tell-tale' signs! What are they? "faith working through love" [Gal 5:6]! Particularly love to God's people! Paul "as we have opportunity let us do good to all people especially to those who belong to the family of believers" [Gal 6:10]! How you/I treat other Xians is very important to God! They are His children and we better not despise them!

Now God knows this will be **hard** for us – so He has put us into situations where we can **practice** this love! God has set us all in **families** – where love **ought** to be the dominant principle. We must love our families – despite their failings! You know we can be **trained** to **love** people! We are commanded to love our **enemies**.

Relationships – every epistle mentions them – with husband/wife, parents/children/ employee/employers etc. Human relations are so, so **important**! Have you noticed that the Ten Commandments are <u>all</u> about **relationships! 4 re God, then 6 re our neighbours!** 'When we say we are **making** time for the family, we are acknowledging they are only part of our lives – whereas God says relationships is what life is **all** about!

Relationships **must** have the **priority** in our lives! To be able to get on with people – all kinds – especially our family. A man who is **not** easily **offended**, that can **control** his anger/temper, that can **suppress** his pride, and **overcome** his greed, and **forgive** an injury, who can **repent** and **apologize** is a man worth his salt – you can do a lot with that Xian.

The **great enemy** of relationships? <u>Busyness!</u> Doing **very lawful/necessary** things! Legitimate work in the home and office! To be **preoccupied** with our own wee area of work and ignoring those around you who are needing for our attention/our interest is a sin that has a heavy cost to pay! The **computer** is much more **attractive** to us!

Do you know what is the **most important gift you** can **give** your family, loved ones, the Church? A lot of people think it is your **money** – but it isn't. It your **time!** Quest: How much do you love Christ? **Answer**: How much **time** do you spend in **His company?** When you give someone your time, you are giving something you **cannot get back**. You can get **money back** – just work overtime! But you can't get yesterday afternoon back – its gone for ever! 'Tomorrow' will only come once. Who are you going to spend it with? Who are you going to spend tomorrow night with – the one you love most? TV, friends, or God? The **best** way to **spell love** is T - I - M - E.

Tolstoy did **not spend TIME** with God or Jesus Christ – and therefore, he had **no time** for his wife or family! Jesus said "whatever you did for **one** of the least of these **My brothers**, you did for **Me**" [Mat 25:40]. Jesus **equates** time spent with His people as time spent with Him! **If** you/I truly **believe** in Jesus "in Him whom He sent", (and thus 'work the work of God') we will understand, unlike Tolstoy, that God's Ideal is **not** our ideal but believing = "faith working thru love" primarily love to God resulting in love to people!
