## Ready to Give a Defense Acts 22:1-21

## **Main Point:**

For the sake of Christ and His gospel, always be ready to give a defense of your faith and ministry.

- 1. There will be times when you need to give a defense for the sake of the gospel.
- 2. In these times, you should be kind and try to establish rapport.
- 3. In these times, you should tell of the change Jesus brought about in you.
- 4. In these times, you should tell of the charge Jesus gave to you.
- 5. In these times, you should be ready.

**Luke 21:12-13** 12 But before all these things, they will lay their hands on you and persecute *you*, delivering *you* up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. 13 But it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony. (NKJV)
