- 2. Review Rm 5:12-21 grace reigns.

1st: Clarification in the Face of Criticism

- 1. <u>v1-2</u> What shall we say then... may it never be! = formula in wh/ Paul articulates a misrepresentation of his teaching & adamantly refutes it.
 - i. Context of court judged & defended.
 - ii. 6:1-2 is similar to 3:1-9a gospel results in moral anarchy?
- 2. <u>6:1-2</u> "Let's sin so that grace will increase!"
 - i. 5:20-21 ungodly logic
 - Bonhoffer: cheap grace; MacArthur: easy believism Rocky Soil. Sin & presume God will forgive: "that's His job" [Heinrich Heine d. 1856]
 - iii. Anti-nomianism elevate grace to give license to sin Jd 1:4
 - **a.** change the grace of God into a license for immorality [NIV]; lasciviousness [KJV & ASV]; sensuality [ESV] licentiousness: dissolute indulgence in sensual pleasure; esp'ly sexual sin [recall Rm 1's trajectory: promiscuity; perversion; depravity of mind]
 - **b.** We tend to look at "them", but "we" are also liable to excuse our favorite sensual indulgence [Rm 13:13-14].
 - iV. Paul warns us against using grace as excuse for moral laxity.

2nd: Our Union with Christ and Commitment to Discipleship

- 1. First half of Rm 6 v1-14 union w/ X in His death & res
- 2. Second half of Rm $6 \underline{v15-23}$ our commitment to X as disciples
- **3.** Paul appeals to what we already *know* v3, v9, v11, v16, 7:1 it is impossible to be a Xn & then live under the reign of sin & death. Grace includes not only justification but also sanctification.
- 4. Stott pts to 5 parallels in the two halves of Rm 6.

- i. Exults in God's grace $5:20 \rightarrow 6:1-14 \& 6:15 \rightarrow v15-23$.
- ii. Answers same question $\underline{6:1}$ & $\underline{6:15}$
- iii. Responds w/ same intense repulsion v2 & v15.
- iV. Our ignorance of gospel & true Xnty <u>v3</u> & <u>v16</u> Reminds of how we began the Xn life.
 - **a.** Stay rooted in rudimentary truths *simplicity and purity of devo- tion to Christ* (2C 11:3)
 - **b.** Retain childlike trust & dependency on Jesus. Job 26:16 *Behold, these are the fringes of His ways*; Hab 3:4 *hiding of His power*
 - **C.** Theology -> worship. He is incomprehensible, but can be known thru the revelation of Himself received in salvation [Jn 17:3]
- V. Radical dif tw/ pre- & post-conversion: $\underline{v2}$ & $\underline{v21-22}$ due to what we were in Adam & are now in Christ [Rn 5:12ff] = contrast of life in this age & life in the age to come.

Applic #1: If We Proclaim the Gospel We Will be Misunderstood & Misjudged

- 1. Sinners can misjudge role of "works" in salvation apart from works.
- 2. Professing Xns also need to know the legitimate role of works avoid legalism & antinomianism.
 - i. preach indicatives [what Jesus is for us: Rm 1-11] & imperatives [what we should do for Jesus: Rm 12:1] Rm 13:8-10 [Rm 3:31].
 - ii. Beware of "just justification" view of salvation: can be antinomian.
- 3. Expect to be misunderstood, but be ready to give an answer

Applic #2: Be Committed to Learn the Doctrines & to Practice the Disciplines of the Biblical Gospel

- 1. Paul addresses the mind & moves the hearts truth & love.
- **2.** Live in the fear of God: meditation ingest Scripture prayer self aware in presence of your Father [2C 6:17].

3. Live in union w/ Jesus as His disciple. Believe Him. Love Him & live in His love.
