SUMMARY STATEMENT



THE SAGA OF THE DRAGON: A RICH ALLEGORY

Allegory: a story, poem, or picture that can be interpreted to reveal a hidden meaning (Oxford)

Purpose: to tell a rich story that makes us feel a certain way so that when we interpret it, we see a new perspective

REVELATION 13:16-18

¹⁶Also it causes all, both small and great, both rich and poor, both free and slave, to be marked on the right hand or the forehead, ¹⁷so that no one can buy or sell unless he has the mark, that is, the name of the beast or the number of its name. ¹⁸This calls for wisdom: let the one who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man, and his number is 666.

**A song of victory and a song of praise,
the redeemed joining in the worship of heaven**

Who shares in this victory over the Beast?

No one could learn that song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth. ⁴It is these who have not defiled themselves with women, for they are virgins. It is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These have been redeemed from mankind as firstfruits for God and the Lamb, ⁵and in their mouth no lie was found, for they are blameless.

God's people are exclusive, set apart by Christ

**God's people are pure, pursuing only Christ
(not defiled by the love of the things of the world)**

God's people are redeemed, they belong to Christ

God's people are holy, they reject the allure of sin

HOW FIRM A FOUNDATION, VERSES 3-4

When through the deep waters I call thee to go

The rivers of sorrow shall not overflow

For I will be with thee, thy troubles to bless,

And sanctify to thee they deepest distress.

When through fiery trials thy pathway shall lie,

My grace, all sufficient, shall be thy supply.

At the heart of the Gospel's message is a declaration that God, not the Beast, is to be feared and worshipped, that God, not the Beast, is Creator and God

It is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These have been redeemed from mankind as firstfruits for God and the Lamb, ⁵and in their mouth no lie was found, for they are blameless. Those who will be sheltered by the Lamb are those who are marked as belonging to the Lamb, those who are marked by pursuing holiness and not the world.

¹³And I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Blessed indeed," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!"

Things aren't going to be easy, but the battle will not last forever. We must endure in obedience and faith until the Lamb claims His victory and our enemies are defeated.

DANIEL 3:14-18

¹⁴Nebuchadnezzar answered and said to them, "Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the golden image that I have set up? ¹⁵Now if you are ready when you hear the sound of the horn, pipe, lyre, trigon, harp, bagpipe, and every kind of music, to fall down and worship the image that I have made, well and good. But if you do not worship, you shall immediately be cast into a burning fiery furnace. And who is the god who will deliver you out of my hands?" ¹⁶Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. ¹⁷If this be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of your hand, O king. ¹⁸But if not, be it known to you, O king, that we will not serve your gods or worship the golden image that you have set up."

³²And what more shall I say? For time would fail me to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets---³³who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, ³⁴quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, were made strong out of weakness, became mighty in war, put foreign armies to flight. ³⁵Women received back their dead by resurrection. Some were tortured, refusing to accept release, so that they might rise again to a better life. ³⁶Others suffered mocking and flogging, and even chains and imprisonment. ³⁷They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were killed with the sword. They went about in skins of sheep and goats, destitute, afflicted, mistreated---³⁸of whom the world was not worthy---wandering about in deserts and mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.

KIDS' QUESTION:
