2. Our sin nature is our flesh that is the enemy of God.	
C. Both this world and our flesh aid Satan is his attacks on God's	
authority in our lives.	
II. Satan's Army	
A. The Soldiers in Satan's Army	
1. Satan's army is made up of fallen angels.	
2. These fallen angels are referred to as devils and unclean or	
evil spirits in the Bible.	
3. There are no evil spirits comprised of the disembodied souls of dead men.	
4. Angels (both fallen and not) have immaterial bodies but can take a form that can be viewed by men.

5. The fallen angels are comprised of about a third of the total number of created angels.
