Sermon: True Thankfulness

Passage: Psalm 138:1-3

Sermon Outline:

Three Relationship Requirements of Biblical Leaders

1. Give Thanks Genuinely (v. 1)
2. Give Thanks Verbally (v. 1)
3. Give Thanks Physically (v. 2)

Review Questions:

1. What does thanking God with “all your heart” mean?”
2. Why does the Psalmist sing rather than speak to the Lord in offering praise?
3. What are some characteristics of God that we can specifically think about in worship?
4. What lesson can we learn from the story of the 10 lepers in Luke 17:11-19?
5. How was worshipping the Lord done with the body in the past? What was its significance?

Discussion Questions:

1. Have you ever given thanks with “all your heart” to the Lord? What about people? On what occasion?
2. How are you like the 1 leper who gives thanks in Luke 17:11-19? How are you like the 9 others?
3. When you sing and worship the Lord, do you think about the truth behind the words? What is the significance of singing in contrast to just talking during worship?
4. Have you worshiped the Lord with your body? Is it important to do it today even if our culture does not practice it? Why or why not?
5. In verse 3, the Psalmist says “On the day I called, You answered me.” When has God answered a prayer in a most amazing way for you? Do you continuously thank God for it?
