- H. A voice like many waters (14:2; 19:6; Ezek. 43:2; Dan. 10:16); cf. Psa 29:3; 93:4
- I. And holding in His right hand seven stars
- J. And coming from His mouth a sharp two-edged sword Isa. 11:4; 49:2; Rev. 2:12; 19:15
- K. And His appearance is as the sun when it shines in its power Matt. 17:2
