## THE LAST ONE | HEBREWS 12:25-29

Because God has now allowed us to approach him with joy,

**Context:** After reminding Christians of the amazing ways we can now approach God in the new covenant era (12:22-24), this passage shows us appropriate ways to respond to Him.

## How to respond to the "new covenant" God:
