## RECEIVE

## REFLECT

- Are you overwhelmed by Christ's grace? Why or why not? What can you learn from Paul regarding gratitude for God's grace?
- In light of this passage, why should we have a high view of the church?

## RESPOND

- How will you apply any gospel encouragement from your reading and reflection for the day and week ahead?
- What areas of your life have you identified that need to have gospel truth applied, in order for you to receive grace and peace from God?
- Spend some time in prayer with the Lord about the things He has revealed to you in this passage.
- Ask God to help you respond in faith to His word.
- Commit to applying whatever gospel encouragement or challenge you have received into practice.
