Sermon: **Psalm 119:49-56**

***The blessings God gives in remembering His Word.***

We see:

1. The prayer for God to *remember*, to work hope in the believer (v.49).
2. The believer *remembers* and receives comfort in all the trials of life (vv.50-53).
3. The believer *remembers* and is given ability to joyfully obey (vv. 54-56).

## The Heidelberg Catechism

**116. Q.** Why is prayer necessary for Christians?

**A.** Because prayer is the most important part of the thankfulness which God requires of us.[1] Moreover, God will give His grace and the Holy Spirit only to those who constantly and with heartfelt longing ask Him for these gifts and thank Him for them.[2]

## The Westminster Confession of Faith

**WCF 21.3** Prayer, with thanksgiving, being one special part of religious worship,(1) is by God required of all men;(2) and, that it may be accepted, it is to be made in the name of the Son,(3) by the help of His Spirit,(4) according to His will,(5) with understanding, reverence, humility, fervency, faith, love, and perseverance;(6) and, if vocal, in a known tongue.(7)

## The Canons of Dort

**{Article 15: Responses to God's Grace}**

God does not owe this grace to anyone. For what could God owe to one who has nothing to give that can be paid back? Indeed, what could God owe to one who has nothing of his own to give but sin and falsehood? Therefore the person who receives this grace owes and gives eternal thanks to God alone; the person who does not receive it either does not care at all about these spiritual things and is satisfied with himself in his condition, or else in self-assurance foolishly boasts about having something which he lacks. Furthermore, following the example of the apostles, we are to think and to speak in the most favorable way about those who outwardly profess their faith and better their lives, for the inner chambers of the heart are unknown to us. But for others who have not yet been called, we are to pray to the God who calls things that do not exist as though they did. In no way, however, are we to pride ourselves as better than they, as though we had distinguished ourselves from them.

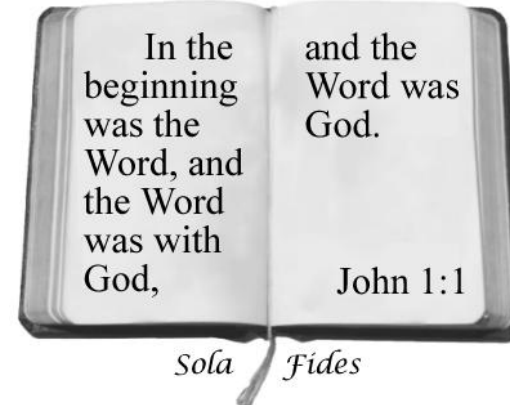
