Text: Luke 7:36-50

1. The setting that initiated the parable
 - a. An entrance that prompts a Parable (vv. 36–40).
 - b. An entrance without acceptance
 - c. Her approach to the situation and her actions

2. An answer to thoughts V40-42
 - a. The story: creditor; two debtors; two debts; both forgiven
 - b. The question: Which one will love him the most? V42
 - c. The answer: The one who is forgiven the most V42
 - d. The response: Your answer is correct. This truth should be easily seen by the person who wants to be honest with themselves.

3. Christ compares actions to identify love 44-47
 - a. This woman has no standing in the community but look at her love. You (Pharisee) have so much yet you did nothing you should have, even as a courtesy.
 - b. Some truth to be considered
 - c. Christ addresses the inner objection of Simon to the woman as a sinner.
