 - B. Joel Beeke: "The Holy Spirit alone can produce an inward confidence that you belong to Christ and Christ belongs to you, resulting in spiritual joy, peace, humility, love, longing for His presence, and desire to do His will. Spiritual assurance is not just a belief that you will be in heaven; it is heaven already begun in you. It is relying on what Christ did for you two thousand years ago and realizing what Christ is doing in your life today." (Faith Seeking Assurance, 2015, Preface)
