she says, 'I sit as a queen, I am no widow, and mourning I shall never see.' ⁸ For this reason her plagues will come in a single day, death and mourning and famine, and she will be burned up with fire; *for mighty is the Lord God who has judged her.*"

¹⁴ Then Death and Hades were thrown into the *lake of fire*. This is *the second death*, the lake of fire. ¹⁵ And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Philippians 3:7–11 — Turn from the Rubbish of Our Righteousness

⁷ But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. ⁸ Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as <u>rubbish</u>, in order that I may gain Christ ⁹ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—

that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, ¹¹ that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

Key Idea

God's eternal Judgment is real and it is terrifying. Turn from your sinful self-reliance & self-service and put your trust fully in the righteousness of Jesus!
