- II. No Other Savior vs. 8-13
 - A. Witnesses (vs. 8-9)
 - 1. Blind who see
 - 2. Deaf who hear
 - 3. Nations who can testify
 - B. Chosen (vs. 10) Rom. 8:29-30
 - 1. To be My Servant
 - 2. To know and believe John 6:26; 10:26
 - 3. To understand John 12:37-41
 - 4. No other God before or after Isa. 57:15
 - C. I AM God (vs. 11-13)
- III. Exodus from Exile vs. 14-21
 - A. The Promise (vs. 14-15)
 - 1. Lord, Redeemer, Holy One
 - 2. Babylon Overthrown
 - 3. The Lord, Holy One, Creator, King
 - B. The Pattern (vs. 16-21)
 - 1. A way through the waters (a path for Israel, a pit for Egypt)
 - 2. New things deliverance, a new world
 - 3. A people saved by water John 4:10-11; 7:38; Rev. 7:17
 - a. Formed = pottery Rom. 9:19-21
 - b. They shall declare My praise Rom. 9:22-29
- IV. False Religion and Reproach vs. 22-28
 - A. You Have Burdened Me (to compel to serve)
 - 1. The Egyptians forced Israel into slavery
 - 2. He Lord's purpose to being them to liberty Exodus 20:2

- 3. The Law, by obedience, brings freedom Psa. 119:45
- 4. But empty religious ritual seeks to manipulate God, making Him the servant, not the Sovereign
- B. You Have Wearied Me Amos 5:21-24; Isa. 1:12-18
 - 1. Religious fervor replaced devotion
 - 2. The people worshipped as they wanted, not as God commanded
 - 3. The sacrifices without obedience (repentance and faith) proved unsatisfactory -1 Sam. 15:22
- C. I Blot Out Your Sins Psa. 51:1-3; Jer. 31:34
 - 1. Remind Me why I should forgive you
 - 2. Sin brings reproach Prov. 14:34; Jer. 3:25
 - 3. Repentance and Confession brings forgiveness and reconciliation 1 John 1:9; Micah 7:18; Isa. 55:7
