Knowing God

Acts 3:11-26 Acts: The Real Church Pastor Phil Winfield November 22, 2015

Peter's sermon had one main point: the Jews should have recognized their Messiah but they didn't. Listen to what Peter preached.

- 1. Knowing God entails listening to the **message** and not focusing on the **messenger** (v.11-12).
- 2. Knowing God requires that you **face the fact** of your guilt (v.13-16).
 - a. You **vainly worshipped** a God that you do not know.
 - b. They delivered and **<u>denounced</u>** Jesus before Pilate.
 - c. They **<u>disowned</u>** the innocent (holy and righteous) one and <u>**desired**</u> a murderer.
 - d. They **<u>killed</u>** the author, originator and the one that leads to life.
- *3.* Knowing God commands **repentance** which yields wonderful results (v.17-22).
 - *a.* God gives space to repent because of our **ignorance** (v.17).
 - *b.* God works his will in spite of **<u>our sin</u>** (v.18).
 - *c.* First result your sins will be **<u>blotted</u>** out (v.19).
 - *d.* Second result times or <u>relief</u> (refreshing) will come (v.19).
 - *e.* Third result Jesus <u>will come</u> to you (v.20-21).
- 4. Knowing God is possible when you take his word *seriously* (v.22-24).
 - a. They had had **<u>ample</u>** warning.
 - *b.* The warning declared **severe judgment** for not receiving the prophet.
- Knowing God is a <u>privilege</u>, a blessing based on receiving and <u>not</u> <u>rejecting</u> Jesus (25-26).
 - a. To have some **prophets** in your life is a tremendous blessing.
 (v.25).
 - b. To have Jesus in your life is a **<u>life changing</u>** blessing (v.26)!
