In Jewish tradition this psalm is known as, The Great Hallel (the great psalm of praise.

Structure:

Give Thanks (vv. 1-3) Creation (vv. 4-9) Deliverance from Slavery in Egypt (vv. 10-15) Wandering & Conquest (vv. 16-22) Providential Care (vv. 23-25) Give Thanks (v. 26)

We are to give thanks to the LORD because of who He is and what He is like. (vv. 1-3, 26)

¹Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.
²Give thanks to the God of gods, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.
³Give thanks to the Lord of lords, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.
²⁶Give thanks to the God of heaven, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

"<u>Give thanks</u>," "is not the whole meaning of this word; it basically means 'confess' or 'acknowledge' and therefore calls us to thoughtful, grateful worship spelling out what we know or have found of God's glory and His deeds." (Kidner, *Psalms*, TOTC, vol. 2, p. 457)

Because of who He is:

To the LORD (YAHWEH)

To the God of gods (1Cor. 8:4-6; 10:19-20; see also Is. 40-46).

To the Lord of lords (Deut. 10:14-17)

To the God of heaven (Pss. 115:3; 135:5-6)

Because of What He is like:

He is good. (Pss. 86:5; 100:5; 106:1; 107:1; 119:68; 135:3)

His lovingkindness is everlasting (Ex. 34:6-7)

"steadfast love," "loyal or faithful love" (Pss. 23:6; 51:1; Deut. 7:7-11)

Give Thanks for His lovingkindness as it is seen in Creation (vv. 4-9)

⁴To Him who alone does great <u>wonders</u>, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;
⁵To Him who made the heavens <u>with skill</u>, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;
⁶To Him who spread out the earth above the waters, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;
⁷To Him who made *the* great lights, For His lovingkindness is everlasting:
⁸The sun to rule by day, For His lovingkindness is everlasting,
⁹The moon and stars to rule by night, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

Genesis 1:1-19

Give Thanks for His lovingkindness as it is seen the Exodus (vv. 10-15)

¹⁰ To Him who smote the Egyptians in their firstborn,	Ex. 12:29
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
¹¹ And brought Israel out from their midst,	Deut. 6:23
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
¹² With a strong hand and an outstretched arm,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting.	
¹³ To Him who divided the Red Sea asunder,	Ex. 14:21
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
¹⁴ And made Israel pass through the midst of it,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting;	
¹⁵ But He overthrew Pharaoh and his army in the Red Sea,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting.	

<u>Give thanks for His lovingkindness as it is seen in Wilderness Wandering and the Conquest</u> (vv. 16-22)

¹⁶To Him who led His people through the wilderness, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;
¹⁷To Him who smote great kings,

For His lovingkindness is everlasting,

¹⁸ And slew mighty kings,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting:	
¹⁹ Sihon, king of the Amorites,	Num. 21:21-24
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
²⁰ And Og, king of Bashan,	Num. 21:33-35
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
²¹ And gave their land as a heritage,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting,	
²² Even a heritage to Israel His servant,	
For His lovingkindness is everlasting.	

Give thanks for His lovingkindness as it is seen in His Providential Care (vv. 23-25)

²³Who remembered us in our low estate, Is. 40:27-31; 49:14-15 For His lovingkindness is everlasting,
²⁴And has rescued us from our adversaries, For His lovingkindness is everlasting;

²⁵Who gives food to all flesh, Ps. 104:25-28
 For His lovingkindness is everlasting. Matt. 6:25-34

Give thanks to the Lord.
