


# SPOTTED BY THE FLESH (SIN OF NAKEDNESS)

## Westminster Larger Catechism:

**"Q. 139. What are the sins forbidden in the seventh commandment?"**

**A. The sins forbidden in the seventh commandment...are, adultery, fornication, rape, incest, sodomy, and all unnatural lusts...all corrupt or filthy communications, or listening thereunto; wanton looks, impudent or light behavior, **immodest apparel**...undue delay of marriage; having more wives or husbands than one at the same time; unjust divorce, or desertion; idleness, gluttony, drunkenness, unchaste company; **lascivious songs, books, pictures, dancings, stage plays; and all other provocations to...**"**

**Leviticus 17:7 And they shall  
no more offer their sacrifices  
unto devils, after whom they  
have gone a whoring...**

**1 Corinthians 10:19** What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered **in sacrifice to idols** is any thing?  
**20** But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, **they sacrifice to devils,** and not to God: and I would not that ye should have **fellowship with devils.**

**Exodus 32:19** And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that **he saw the calf**, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

**Exodus 32:25** And when Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had **made them naked** unto their shame among their enemies:)  
**28...and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men.**

**Deuteronomy 9:20 And the LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I prayed for Aaron also the same time.**

**Luke 8:27** And when he went forth to land, there met him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in any house, but in the tombs.

**Luke 8:35** Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, **out of whom the devils were departed**, sitting at the feet of Jesus, **clothed**, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

**"1. A cloth or piece of leather worn on the forepart of the body, to keep the clothes clean, or defend them from injury." (*Webster's*, 1828)**

**"3. Not loose; not lewd." (*Webster's*, 1828)**

**"*Of women*, their attributes and behavior, governed by the proprieties of the sex...not...impudent or lewd; 'shamefast'...*Of female attire*: Decent, not meretricious [1 Tim. 2:9]...Inoffensive to decency."
