## Further Considerations

### **Joshua 24:1-13**

To whom do the people of Israel present themselves? What specific elements of Israel's history does Joshua highlight? What is he seeking to impress upon the nation? How does remembering God's faithfulness in the past motivate you to trust the Lord in the present?

### **Joshua 24:14-15**

How is Israel to serve the Lord? Who does Joshua indicate had served other gods? What is the family significance mentioned here? In what ways does the surrounding culture hinder our serving the Lord? Read Deuteronomy 6:4-8. In what ways are you to teach your children? What are some practical steps that you find helpful in providing spiritual instruction in your home? How does Joshua declare his personal commitment? How can we encourage one another to do the same?

### **Joshua 24:16-23**

Why does Joshua seemingly discourage Israel's commitment to serve the Lord? What does He tell them about God?

### **Joshua 24:24-28**

How did Joshua stress the importance of the decision the Israelites claimed to make? What "witness" did Joshua establish to remind the people of their commitment? Where else in Joshua do you find stones that serve as memorials? In what ways does this challenge you to be more serious in your spiritual walk?
