Hebrews 12:5 And ye have

30 In vain have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your own sword hath devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion.

31 O generation, see ye the word of the LORD...

32 Can a maid forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? yet my people have forgotten me days without number.

**Proverbs 13:15 Good
understanding giveth
favour: but **the way of
transgressors is hard.****

**Proverbs 13:24 He that
spareth his rod hateth his
son: but he that loveth him
chasteneth him betimes.**

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

**Proverbs 29:15 The rod and
reproof give wisdom: but a
child left to himself bringeth
his mother to shame.**

**Jeremiah 5:3...thou hast stricken them,
but they have not grieved; thou hast
consumed them, but they have refused
to receive correction: they have made
their faces harder than a rock; they
have refused to return.**

Proverbs 23:35 They have stricken me, shalt thou say, and I was not sick; they have beaten me, and I felt it not: when shall I awake? I will seek it yet again.

Proverbs 27:22 Though thou
shouldst bray a fool in a
mortar among wheat with a
pestle, **yet will not his
foolishness depart from him.**

1 Samuel 6:9...if it goeth up by the way of his own coast to Bethshemesh, then he hath done us this great evil: but if not, then we shall know that it is not his hand that smote us: **it was a chance that happened to us.**

Ezekiel 13:22 Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; **and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way,** by promising him life:

Ecclesiastes 8:11 Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.

**Galatians 6:7 Be not
deceived; God is not mocked:
for whatsoever a man soweth,
that shall he also reap.**

**James 5:7...Behold, the
husbandman **waiteth** for the
precious fruit of the earth,
and hath long patience for
it...**

2 Samuel 7:14 I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men:

**Isaiah 10:5 O Assyrian, the
rod of mine anger, and the
staff in their hand is mine
indignation.**

1 Corinthians 11:30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

31 For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

32 But when we are judged, we are **chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.**

Proverbs 2:7 He layeth up
sound wisdom for **the**
righteous...

Luke 8:18 Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.

**Proverbs 13:9 The light of the
righteous rejoiceth: but the
lamp of the wicked shall be put
out.**

Romans 1:24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:

28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

**Psalms 69:27 Add iniquity
unto their iniquity: and let
them not come into thy
righteousness.**

Psalms 81:11 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me.

12 So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust: and they walked in their own counsels.

**Jeremiah 2:35 Yet thou sayest,
Because I am innocent, surely his
anger shall turn from me. Behold, I
will plead with thee, because thou
sayest, I have not sinned.**

Hebrews 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.

CHASTE:

"Pure from unlawful sexual intercourse...virtuous...Morally pure, free from guilt, innocent..."

(Oxford Dictionary)

CHASTE (v):

"1. To correct or **amend** by discipline."

"2. To reprove, rebuke."

"3. To inflict corrective punishment on."

CHASTEN:

"1. To inflict disciplinary or corrective punishment on; to visit with affliction for the purpose of moral improvement..."

"2. To punish..."

"3. To render chaste or pure in character or style; to purify, refine."

Proverbs 19:18 Chasten
thy son while there is
hope, and let not thy soul
spare for his crying.

**Revelation 3:19 As many as I
love, I rebuke and **chasten**:
be zealous therefore, and
repent.**

Leviticus 26:27 And if ye will not for all this hearken unto me, but walk contrary unto me;

28 Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

**Daniel 10:12 Then said he unto me,
Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day
that thou didst set thine heart to
understand, and to **chasten** thyself
before thy God, thy words were heard,
and I am come for thy words.**

Psalm 69:10 When I wept,
and **chastened** my soul
with fasting...

**Psalms 73:13 Verily I have cleansed
my heart in vain, and washed my
hands in innocency.**

**14 For all the day long have I been
plagued, and **chastened** every
morning.**

2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

John 15:2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

James 1:2 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations;

9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses **for Christ's sake: for **when I am weak, then am I strong.****
