



Use It Or Lose It!

Luke 19:11-27



- 1) The ultimate kingdom of God will occur at Jesus' future return
 - a) Though God's kingdom came w/ Jesus of Nazareth, Jesus first had to depart before returning to receive His full kingdom—yet future
 - b) When Jesus departed, He gave gifts to His people to build His Church (Eph. 4:8-12)
 - c) When Jesus returns, His people will be held accountable for how they used His gifts
 - i) The faithful will be given great responsibilities in eternity
 - ii) The unfaithful are rebuked & forfeit eternal rewards
 - iii) The truly diligent will receive more than the rest
 - d) Those who object to Jesus as King will be judged severely
- 2) The will of God is being accomplished during Jesus' absence
 - a) God will banish Israel's rebellion & redeem the remnant while we await Christ's return
 - b) God is daily molding all who await Christ's return
 - c) God's delay allows Him to draw all His elect to Christ (2 Pet. 3:3-9)
- 3) All our possessions belong to God who gave them to us, to be used for His glory, not ours
 - a) He owns our bodies & abilities
 - b) He owns our time
 - c) He owns our wealth
- 4) Application question: What has God given you, and what are you doing with it?
