B. Greatness - "neither bond nor free"

C. Gender - "neither male nor female"

III. Promise - "according to the promise" (v. 29)

Participating in:

A. Belonging – "If ye be Christ's"

B. Blessing - "then are ye Abraham's seed"

C. Benefiting - "and heirs according to the promise"
