#### Introduction

- I Peter 5:6-9
  - We must resist the Devil by faith in God
  - Walk humbly
- We have a real enemy to our soul
  - Understanding our enemy is beneficial

## The Origin of Satan

- 1) Made by God Col. 1:16
  - This is a mystery to why God would create Satan
  - Let us not doubt the nature of God

Habakkuk 1:13 – "You are of purer eyes than to behold evil, and cannot look on wickedness."

I John 1:5 – "This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all."

- He was made for the glory of God (Rev. 4:11)

# The Origin of Satan

- 2) Satan is a fallen angel -
  - "Devil and His angels" (Matt. 25:41)
  - Eph. 6:11-12
    - -He has power and rulers of darkness

- 3) Account of Satan's Fall Context are earthly kings
  - Isaiah 14: 12-17
    - Desires to exalt himself above God
  - Ezekiel 28:12-18
    - Created with the talent of music

- Satan's fall is traced to the sin of pride and rebellion
- John 8:44 "You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it."

### The Work of Satan

- 1) Satan introduced sin in the human family **Gen. 3:1-5** 
  - Caused man to doubt God's Word
  - Led mankind into sin
  - Desires to use man to overcome God
  - Satan wants us be like him and to lead others into sin

#### The Work of Satan

- 2) Satan possesses and controls the world that is opposed to God
  - God has permitted Satan to have dominion over the world system
    - Matthew 4:8-10
      - Wants our worship
  - "prince of this world" John 12:31, 14:30 and 16:11
  - "god of this world" II Cor. 4:4
  - I John 5:18-20

- 3) Satan accuses God's people
  - Devil means accuser or slanderer
  - Job 1:6, 9; 2:3-5
    - Unbelievers rejoice when followers of Christ sin

## -Rev. 12:9-10

"[Satan] sometimes slanders God to men; as to Eve... sometimes men to God; as Job... and continually, man to man."

- Satan loves for us to accuse one another so he may divide us

- 4) Satan tests, hinders, resists and buffets the people of God
  - Luke 22:31-32
  - I Thess. 2:18
  - II Cor. 12:7
    - "buffet" means to rap or beat with the fist
