- 1. It is true. (Rom. 9:11, Eph. 1:4, John 6, 17)
- 2. The aim of unconditional election is that we are destined for eternal joy and praise of the glory of the grace of God—our destiny. (Eph. 1:6)
- 3. It humbles our proud hearts. (1 Cor. 1:27)
- 4. It makes clear our faith is a gift of God's grace. (Acts 13:48)
- 5. It secures the reality that no one can successfully bring a charge against us. (Rom. 8:31)
- 6. It is the deepest ground of our own compassion for other people. (Col. 3:12)
- 7. Despair at being "unsavable" is torpedoed by unconditional election. (Rom 5:8)
- 8. It puts an end to racism when God's people grasp what it means. (1 Peter 2:9)
- 9. We can know that we are chosen. (1 Thess 1:4)
- 10. God Shapes all of history for the sake of his elect. (Matt 24:22)
