I recognize that it took us very long to get here – Revelation 6
Some of it was planned (time off), but some of it was also intentional
When I committed to teaching Revelation, I knew it was going to be a difficult up-hill battle

How can we be sure what we're learning is true or on the right path?
 And the short answer to that is – by teaching and supporting everything with SCRIPTURE!

By not controlling the narrative of Scripture to support your view
 Instead by allowing the Scripture to control the narrative to support its own view

Real In other words, allow the Scripture to interpret itself!

And if we're going to do that – then the teacher (that would be me) needs to do whatever it takes to get to that place where we are building on solid ground, on a solid foundation

☑ I, as your teacher, needed to do what it takes to get up to speed☑ This is the WHY reason why it took us 2+ years to get here

- Real after we've done our diligence in viewing our Daniel Series, the Great Olivet Discourse from a historical perspective and keeping in mind the "day for a thousand years" principle, my degree on confidence has increased
 - Not that my estimation of myself should be the standard, but as a teacher who must give an account for what I'm teaching, I can in a good conscience and sincerity of faith declare before you and before our Lord Jesus that I've done the best I can with the Spirit's help and leading

OVERVIEW

Now that we learned how to view prophecies in its historical context
 We'll do the same for Revelation ("the prophecy") and view it in its historical context too

- Revelation is relevant to not just the church during the end times, but to all churches for all time!
 - **G** From its inception the end of the age!
 - Get Hence the promise "blessed is He who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it, for the time is near" Rev 1:3 is applicable to all believers for all time!

Q: Who are the Four Horseman? 2 3 Rider on a Rider on a Rider on a Rider on a WHITE HORSE **BLACK HORSE** PALE GREEN HORSE **RED HORSE**

Contrary to Popular Opinion

Contrary to much popular teachings these 4 riders are NOT merely figurative or symbolic:

- ₩hite horse: world peace (false peace), series of false Messiahs, Antichrist, world forces, political conquest, purity of the church
- Red horse: color of blood, holocaust of war, civil war, removal of peace



Looked to Scripture



The context: God spoke to Zechariah the prophet and declared that He was very angry with Israel



God commanded Zechariah to exhort them to come back to God that He may return to them
To not be like their fathers whom the former prophets proclaimed
That they repent of their evil ways and deeds

To heed the Mosaic covenant they entered into
But as discussed to lister

Realize the start of the start


Return to me

AND I WILL

Recurn to you!

So 3 months later, God spoke to Zechariah again in a night vision
Zechariah saw a man riding on a red horse standing among the myrtle trees

 There also were other red, reddish brown and white horses behind him
 There was an angel nearby and Zechariah asked him what are these?



The angel responded, they are the ones the LORD has sent out to patrol the earth

TRANSLATION: The red, reddish brown and white horses are ridden by angels sent out to patrol the earth!

The ones easth ZECHARIAH 1:S-1 In a vision during the night, I are a man utting on a red horse that was standing among some myrtle trees in a small valley. Behind him were riders on red, brown, and white horses.

A: Who are the Four Horseman?

Zch 1 gave us the answer:

R The riders on colored horses in Zch 1 are angels; which means:

R The riders on colored horses in Rev 6 are angels

Parallel between Zch 1 & Rev 6

God was angry with Israel in Zch 1 and sent angels to patrol the earth
God too was angry with Israel in Rev 6 and sent angels to patrol the earth
Remember God's judgment is "to the Jew first"
TRANSLATION: The Four Horseman are 4 angels summoned and sent to patrol the earth, report back, and carry out their assigned tasks!

Parallel between Zch 1 & Rev 6

Surprisingly, no commentary that I came across came up with this biblical definition as to who these 4 Horseman are!

Sadly instead they put their subjectivity to work, over spiritualized the text in many cases, and controlled the narrative to support their eschatology

Revelation 6

Revelation 6:1-8 (NASB)

The First Seal

1 Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." 2 I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

The Second Seal

3 When He broke the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." 4 And another, a red horse, went out; and to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that men would slay one another; and a great sword was given to him.

Revelation 6

The Third Seal

5 When He broke the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, "Come." I looked, and behold, a black horse; and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. 6 And I heard something like a voice in the center of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not damage the oil and the wine."


The Fourth Seal

7 When the Lamb broke the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come." 8 I looked, and behold, an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.

Rev 6:1: The 1st Seal

1 Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come."

- "Then I saw" can be rendered "Also I saw" this vision flows in sequence chronologically
- "when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals" – straightforward the Lamb as if slain broke the 1st of 7 Seals
 - What do the 7 Seals contain again? Ezk 2:10
- Que of the 4 Living Creatures made a summon, "Come."



Rev 6:2: The 1st Seal

2 I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

John sees a rider on a white horse
Again whose the rider? Hint: Zch 1
This rider "had a bow" [review this]
"crown was given to him"[review this]
And John describes that he went out "conquering and to conquer" [review this]



"had a bow"

We learned "bow" is toxon and is used just this 1x in the entire NT
 When we did a holistic view of toxon's Hebrew equivalent word qesheth (in OT) we learned bow or qesheth can have several meanings depending on context:

- Refer to hunting (with actual bow + arrow)
- **R** Figurative of might
- Rainbow
- 础 War or weapon of war
- Real Impending attack (bend a bow)

"had a bow"

Since bow (tóxon) + "crown" + "conquering and to conquer" is the context, the bow (tóxon) is to be understood as <u>a bow of war</u>
 TRANSLATION: The 1st angel riding a white horse is summoned and given a specific task – TO WAGE WAR!

CR This rider was also given a crownCR Let's review this

"a crown was given to him"

John says "a crown was given to him"
 "crown" is stephanos which we covered extensively in Our Promised Crown study awhile back

Like qesheth, crown or stephanos can have several meanings depending on context



Stephanos

- Stephanos was used 18x in the NT and can mean an actual crown worn on the head (worn by kings, crown of thorns, crown of a wreath) or figurative (such as joy and crown (Phi 4; 1Th 2:19), crown of righteousness, crown of life, or crown of glory)
- Real on our immediate context I'm inclined to say that this angel on a white horse "was given holding a [physical albeit heavenly] bow + given a [physical albeit heavenly] crown". For example:
 - 🛯 Letter to Smyrna: those who are faithful in death, were given a crown of life
 - Construct Sthe Seal: those who were slain because of the word of God and the testimony they maintained were given a white robe and asked to rest a little longer until the number of their fellow servants were to be killed as they were

INTERPRETIVE CHALLENGE

A John says "and there was given him a crown"
Was it given to him and he wore it?
Was it given to him and he will hold it to crown someone else with it?
It could be either or both
Remember this principle we learned from the Ram and the Goat study What happens in the heavenlies will manifest itself in the physical!

Rere's what we know...

WHAT WE KNOW

In Context:

This 1st rider on a white horse, was summoned and given a bow+crown
This angel on a white horse was given a specific task to wage war
This angel was given a crown

TRANSLATION: This angel was tasked to wage war, and thus, it will certainly manifest itself on earth!

So it wouldn't surprise me one bit if an actual figure arrived/arrives on the scene in the past/future, is coronated with an actual crown
And this angel or his representative goes from there and begins...

"conquering and to conquer"

- "conquering and to conquer" is the Greek verb nikaō and its root word is nikē
- nikē means exactly how its translated, to conquer, be victorious, prevail, overcome, subdue
- ᢙ How will this be manifested on this side of heaven?
- Presumably, through wars, rumors of wars, nation rising up against nation and kingdom against kingdom
 As far as when the 1st Seal began...




CONJECTURE


Initially, I've maintained that the 1st Seal has not been broken yet
Because of the synergies with the 4 Great Beasts and 4 Living Creatures


C³This explains the video we watched that appeared to capture an angelic being riding a green colored horse (the 3rd Seal)




Revelation (95/96AD – end of the age)

G This angel has been very active since the fall of the Roman empire! Even to this day!

Rere's a list of wars from chatGPT...
