## Next Timeline of Rapture and End Times Update

How long is the peace deal with Israel set to be? Seven years.

Daniel 9:24-27

Who is it that confirms this covenant with Israel? Yes, the Antichrist.

And the same person who signs it will break it at the mid-point. That is all clear and explicit in Daniel 9. Can anyone disagree with that? If you do, you are disagreeing with the Bible's timeline, and your opinion is both invalid and to be rejected.

Ok, so the seven year covenant is confirmed by the Antichrist. But that... that won't happen until after what? Until after the restrainer is removed – meaning the rapture.

Note before preceding – nothing of Revelation 4:2-19:10 refers to the church. The words are directed to Israel. Looking to justify a mid- or post- trib rapture from there does not work, because the words are not written about the church. You have mixed dispensations.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-17 (order of the actual rapture events)

5:1-3 (Times and Seasons repeat from Jesus – Acts 1:6, 7 / Day of the Lord warning; thief in the night)

5:4, 5 (not in darkness; sons of the light – this is an obvious pretrib inference. If the Day of the Lord – the Tribulation period – is darkness, and we are sons of the light, then we are not to be found in darkness).

2 Thess 1:6-10 refers to the tribulation coming upon the world. After that, 2 Thessalonians 2 gives the timeline for what will occur as laid out next...

That is also explicit from 2 Thessalonians 2 -

Now, brethren, <u>concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering</u> <u>together to Him</u>, we ask you, <sup>2</sup> not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though <u>the day of Christ</u> had come. <sup>3</sup>Let no one deceive you by any means; for <u>that Day will not come</u> unless <u>the falling away comes first</u>, <u>and the man of sin is revealed</u>, the son of perdition, <sup>4</sup> who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

<sup>5</sup> Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things? <sup>6</sup> And <u>now you know what is restraining</u>, that he may be revealed in his <u>own time</u>. <sup>7</sup> For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only <u>He who now</u> <u>restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way</u>. (Kai tote apokalyphthēsetai – And THEN will be revealed.) <sup>8</sup> And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.
