Trust in YHWH

Moses' extraordinary encounter with God must have been a monumental, life-changing, perspective shaping experience for him. It was certainly a growth spirt for his faith, and it should have sparked a tremendous growth spurt in his confidence for leadership. He now knew God better than he ever did before. God describes Himself to awestruck Moses as "I AM." This is not so much a name as it is a description of being. There may be many gods, and many names for God, but there is only one "I AM."
