

***A Wife for Isaac***  
**Genesis 24:1-67**

Main Point:

The marriage of Isaac and Rebekah was ultimately for your salvation; therefore, rejoice in it as you concern yourself with the unfolding of God's redemptive plan today.

1. Isaac needed a wife so that God's plan of redemption would continue to unfold.
2. Finding such a wife required faithful obedience and faith-filled prayer on the part of Abraham's servant.
3. God sovereignly gave success to the servant's mission in keeping with His covenant to Abraham.
4. Since this marriage was ultimately for you, you should rejoice in it as you concern yourself with the unfolding of God's redemptive plan today.
