# His People Deuteronomy 1:1-8

## Our God gives us:

- **I.** Commands "the Lord had given...commandment" (vs. 1-3)

  Messages that relate to the:
- A. Orator "the words which Moses spake unto all Israel"
- **B.** Occasion "it came to pass in the fortieth year"
- C. Origin "all that the Lord had given him...unto them"
- II. Compassion "After He had slain Sihon" (vs. 4-6)

  Mercy extended to the:
  - A. Lost "Og the king of Bashan, which dwelt at Ashtaroth"
  - B. Leaders "in the land of Moab began Moses to declare the law"
  - C. Lingering "ye have dwelt long enough in this mount"
- III. Callings "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ" (vs. 7-8)

  Ministry with a:
- A. People "to...the Canaanites"
- B. Place "I have set the land before you"
- C. Purpose "go in and possess the land"
