### Daniel's Deep Devotion to God

Daniel: God's Sovereign Rule Over Human History, part 14 Daniel 6:1-12

- Why would Daniel bow his knees in the public view of his enemies and risk the threat of death? Earlier in his life, Daniel led a "life and death" prayer meeting and prayed to avoid death (Daniel 2:18-23). Now we see Daniel bow his knees in prayer, and he faces death.
- It is said that the average American prays less than 5 minutes per day. Only 18% of born again Christians read the Bible every day. 23% never read the Bible at all.

stood praying, and God would have heard him. He could have prayed silently, and God would have heard him. But he does none of these things. Why? To show that the freedom to worship God is a freedom that cannot and must not be surrendered. If one surrenders that freedom, they are enslaved.


