



Pamagat: Ang Mga Katangian ng mga Bulaang Guro (False Teachers) part 2

Bible Text: 2 Pet. 2:4-9 “For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment; (v.5) And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly; (v.6) And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly; (v.7) And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: (v.8) (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;) (v.9) The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

Pagsasalin: (v.4) Maging ang mga anghel na nagkasala ay hindi pinaligtas ng Diyos; itinaon niya sila sa itim na mundo, kung saan sila’y iginapos sa kadiliman at doon paghihintayin hanggang paghuhukom.

Panimula:

1. Ito ang dahilan kung bakit isinulat ni Pedro ang ikalwang liham: upang magbigay ng babala patungkol sa mga bulaang guro.
2. “To be forewarned is to be forarmed” – Kapag binigyan ka ng babala, dapat maginghanda.

I. Ang Tatlong mga Halimbawa ng Apostasiva:

- A. Apostate Angels (v.4) – (cf. Jude 6-7; 1 Pet. 3:18-19; Gen. 6:1-4)
 - A.1. God judged them and confined them to “hell” (Tartaroo) – pinakamalalim na kalaliman. (Luke 8:31)
 - A.2. Nais ng mga apostate angels na wasakin ang Seed Promise ng Panginoon.
- B. Apostate Old World (v.5) – “the world of the ungodly”
 - B.1. God judge them and destroyed them in the flood.
 - B.2. God saved Noah and his family.
- C. Apostate Cities (v.6) –
 - C.1. God judged them by turning them into “ashes” (abo). – nagaalab na bunton ng abo.
 - C.2. God saved Lot – “just Lot,” “righteous soul,”

II. Ang Kaligtasan ng Mga Mananampalataya:

- A. “The Lord knoweth” (Ps. 1:6; 37:18; 94:11; 1 Cor. 3:20; 2 Tim. 2:19)
- B. “the godly” – saved – Like Noah, and Lot.
- C. “temptations” – mga pagdurusa
- D. “to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished” - maglaan ng mga di-matuwid sa ilalim ng kaparusahan hanggang sa araw ng paghuhukom;

Katapusan:

1. Katakot-takot ang hatol ng mga apostates.
2. Ingatan natin na hindi tayo masama sa paglilinglang ng mga apostates: false teachers.
