Introduction

- Truth telling is one ideal we value in America
- Ways in which we value Truth
- People have been known to shade or distort the truth

The God of Truth

A. Our God is the True God-- the God of Truth

1. Selected passages of Scripture depicting God as True
1 John 5:20; Jeremiah 10:10; Ps. 31:5; John 14:6
2. Definition of “Truth”-- John 18:37
 - a. “That which conforms to or accurately depicts reality.”
 - b. When applied to God, we mean that God’s knowledge, declarations, and representations eternally conform to reality.
3. Illustration of “Un-truth”-- Satan himself-- John 8:44
 - a. “No truth” in Satan
 - b. Natural at lying
4. God, because he is true, cannot lie—Num. 23:19; Tit 1:2

B. If God is true, then His WORD is true. -- John 17:17; Ps 119:160

1. God’s Word accurately describes reality of what has been and is.
2. God’s Word accurately predicts what will be in the future.

C. If God is true, then All truth is absolutely true.

- a. The opposite of absolute truth in Scripture is not relative truth, but mythology or a lie.
- b. Because God is truth, we have a framework on which to view and evaluate life as it really is.
- c. All truth is God’s truth. Therefore we do not need to be afraid of learning for it all points to God.
