

Genesis 12:1-3

Now the LORD said to
Abram,

Genesis 13:14-16

The LORD said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him, "Now raise your eyes and look from the place where you are, northward and southward, and eastward and westward;

for all the land which you see I will give to you and to your descendants forever.

I will make your descendants as plentiful as the dust of the earth, so that if anyone can count the dust of the earth, then your descendants could also be counted.



Genesis 15:4-6

Then behold, the word of the LORD came to him, saying, "This man will not be your heir; but one who will come from your own body shall be your heir."

And He took him outside and said, "Now look toward the heavens and count the stars, if you are able to count them."

And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be."

Then he believed in the LORD; and He credited it to him as righteousness.

Genesis 15:13-16

Then God said to Abram, "Know for certain that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, where they will be enslaved and oppressed for four hundred years.

But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.

As for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you will be buried at a good old age.

Then in the fourth generation they will return here, **for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet complete.**"



Genesis 17:4-8

"As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you,
And you will be the father of a multitude of nations.

"No longer shall you be named Abram,
But your name shall be Abraham;
For I have made you the father of a multitude of nations.

I will make you exceedingly fruitful, and I will make nations of you, and kings will come from you.

I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you throughout their generations as an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you.

And I will give to you and to your descendants after you the land where you live as a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God."
