Preparatory Introduction

- I. Only believers receive the manifold blessings of salvation found in Jesus Christ.
- II. How does Christ open up these blessings to His people and keep them from those who are not?

The Key Power of the Preaching

I. The Open and Closed Kingdom

A. The citizens of the kingdom of heaven experience the blessings and riches of living under the sovereign rule of the Lord Jesus Christ (John 3:18, 36).

B. How do God's people experience the blessings of this kingdom? How is this kingdom protected from the kingdom of darkness in this world? Through the keys of the kingdom.

II. The Powerful Preaching

A. We have to understand what the preaching of the gospel is (Col. 1:28, 29).

B. What does this preaching do? Jesus Christ opens and closes the kingdom through the preaching.

III. The Divine Declaration

- A. A. 84 says that unbelievers "stand exposed to the wrath of God and eternal condemnation, so long as they are unconverted; according to which testimony of the gospel God sill judge them both in this and in the life to come."
- B. But through the preaching, Christ says to believers, your sins are really forgiven for the sake of Christ's merits. You are my sheep.
