- 4. Read **Romans 12:17-21**. What are some of the specific prayers you can and should pray for your opponents "when you are hated, excluded, reviled or spurned on account of the Son of Man?"
- 5. Read **1 Peter 2:21-23**. How can you keep this ultimate example in your mind next time you are tempted to "revile in return?"
