How to Witness to Others Acts 2:14-41

Main Point:

Peter's sermon is a good example of how to witness to others; therefore, learn from him as those who have been called to do the same.

1. In witnessing to others, use the Bible.

2. In witnessing to others, speak about the work of God through Jesus Christ.

3. In witnessing to others, tell them their need for salvation and how they can be given it.

4. In witnessing to others, call them to respond to the gospel and pray for the Spirit to work.
