You must endure all suffering for the gospel, because through suffering the gospel goes forth for salvation with eternal glory.

I.	Remember Jesus Christ (2:8; 2 Sam 7:16; Rom 1:3-4)

- II. Remember Paul (2:9-10)
  - A. Paul is bound by chains for the gospel (Luke 23:32-33)
  - B. Even so, the gospel is unbound and advancing (Phil 1:12-14)
- III. Remember the Trustworthy Saying (2:11-13)
  - A. If we have died with him, we will also live with him (Rom 6:8ff; Gal 2:20)
  - B. If we endure, we will also reign with him (Matt 10:22; 19:28; Rev 22:5)
  - C. If we deny him, he also will deny us (Matt 10:22-23)
  - D. If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful—for he cannot deny himself (Ps 40:11; 2 Thes 3:3; 1 Thes 5:23-24)
