I.  $\mathbf{F}$  aith – "that your faith grows exceedingly" (vs. 1-3) A faith that is:

- A. Grateful "to thank God always for you"
- **B.** Genuine "as it is meet"
- C. Growing "grows exceedingly"

**II. F**ellowship - "in the churches of God" (vs. 3-4)

A fellowship that is:

- A. Compassionate "and the charity of every one"
- B. Contagious "every one of you all toward each other"
- C. Commendable "So that we ourselves glory in you"

III. Fidelity - "that you may be counted worthy" (vs. 4-5)

A fidelity that comes with:

- A. Perseverance "tribulations that you endure"
- **B.** Proof "manifest token of the righteous judgment of God"
- *C.* Persecution "for which you also suffer"
