v 9-11 God's Reminder - The Barrenness of a secular life

The selfish pursuit of temporal, worldly activities results in drought, loss and disappointment.

The Lord will not bless such pursuits.

God withholds blessings from disobedient children

II. A Confident Assurance v 12 - 15

v 12 Then ... all the remnant of the people obeyed the voice of the Lord... and the words

v 13 I am with you, saith the Lord

Lost people avoid the truth, *because their are evil* (Jn 3:19). Christians avoid serving the Lord because their old nature hates Holiness. They see the 'negative' aspects of holy living and serving God. God does not 'walk with you' until you begin serving Him. He dispenses serving grace after you commence action. **2 Cor 9:6-11**, **Eph 3:14-19** The *fruit of the Spirit* is only borne in the 'summer' heat of service. Gal 5:22-23 This is why most saints never experience spiritual peace. Paul wrote : *work out your salvation with <u>fear and trembling</u>. Phil 2:12 The Bible prepares us with the negative view before we take the right action. Num 13:30-33 God waits for us to make the right move (not just the right decision) to test our love for Him. When we take action, the Lord shows up at the right time, removes the opposition (Ezra 6), and gives the victory (1 Cor 15:57, Phil 4:13).*

We experience His joyous fruit presently, and He rewards us eternally.
