1st Beast: like a Lion

Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it.

Last week we covered: -who is likened to a Lion in Scripture -what do "wings of an eagle" signify

But what we didn't cover is the latter half of v. 4





Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and <u>it was lifted up from the ground</u> and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to <u>it</u>.

- ☆ 'lifted' is 'netal' in Aramaic which means raised
- netal' corresponds to 'natal' in Hebrew which interestingly also means to offer up

2 Samuel 24 (God is going to discipline David for taking Census)

12"Go [God speaking to Gad the prophet] and speak to David, 'Thus the LORD says, "I am <u>offering [natal]</u> you three things; choose for yourself one of them, which I will do to you."

Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and <u>it was lifted up from the ground</u> and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to <u>it</u>.

- ≪ "two feet like a man" is "regal enash" in Aramaic which figuratively
 describes the feet of a giant statue that is stood up like man

Daniel 7:4 The first was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and <u>it was lifted up from the ground and made to</u> <u>stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it</u>.

- (x 'yehab' corresponds to 'yahab' in Hebrew which means to ascribe or provide

Revelation 13:11-15 (after the 7th Trumpet)


11 Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth; and he (the beast of the earth) had two horns like a lamb and he spoke as a dragon. 12 He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. And he makes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed. 13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down out of heaven to the earth in the presence of men. 14 And he deceives those who dwell on the earth because of the signs which it was given him to perform in the presence of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who had the wound of the sword and has come to life. 15 And it was given to him (the beast of the earth) to give breath to the image of the beast (of the sea), so that the image of the beast (of the sea) would even speak and cause as many as do not worship the image of the beast to be killed.

- In Dan 7:4b: the Lion in Daniel's four beast vision was given <u>a human mind</u>
 In Rev 13: the beast from the earth <u>gave breath</u> (pneuma or spirit) <u>to the</u> <u>image</u> (eikōn or statue) so that it (the eikōn statue) <u>would even speak</u>
- All this is to say, Artificial-Lifelike-Intelligence and some sort of demonic activity seems to be in play in both of these prophecies
 - Glimpses of an artificial human mind can be seen with Siri, Alexa



Meet Sophia The 1st humanoid with citizenship

In 2017, Sophia made history by becoming the first android to be granted legal citizenship . The humanoid , with nationality of <u>Saudi Arabia</u>, has made several controversial statements, but the most recent has left the world speechless: she wants to have a robot baby and start a family .

I say all this to say:

- This would place the Lion and the rest of the four beasts in Daniel's vision not in the past (historical), but in the future (where there is advanced civilization, including an advancement in technology)
- Those who argue that the Lion or any of the four beasts were historical kings, they will need to reconcile Dan 7:4b and "a human mind" was given to it (a statue like a man)
- As we progress in our studies, we will find that the four beasts in Daniel's vision more naturally and progressively places the four kings towards the latter times (historical kings are just glimpses)
 When we get to Rev 10, 13 this will be supported further
 Lion/Bear/Leopard all mentioned

Daniel 7

Daniel 7:1-8 (NASB) - Daniel's Vision of Four Beasts

1 In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel saw a dream and visions in his mind as he lay on his bed; then he wrote the dream down and related the following summary of it. 2 Daniel said, "I was looking in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the great sea. 3 And four great beasts were coming up from the sea, different from one another. 4 The first was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it. 5 And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a bear. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth between its teeth; and thus they said to it, 'Arise, devour much meat!' 6 After this I kept looking, and behold, another one, like a leopard, which had on its back four wings of a bird; the beast also had four heads, and dominion was given to it. 7 After this I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong; and it had large iron teeth. It devoured and crushed and trampled down the remainder with its feet; and it was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns. 8 While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first horns were pulled out by the roots before it; and behold, this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and a mouth uttering great boasts.

Daniel sees the 1st of 4 kings arise from the Mediterranean Sea (Mediterranean nation) that was part of Ancient Assyria/Ancient Babylon:



Daniel 7:5 And behold, another beast, a second one, <u>resembling a bear</u>. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth between its teeth; and thus they said to it, 'Arise, devour much meat!'




Identification of the Four Kingdoms of Daniel's visions

Daniel's Captivity Spanned 4 Kings: Babylon's Nebuchadnezzar to Belshazzar who lost his kingdom to the Medo-Persians. Then Darius the Mede took over (who threw Daniel into the lion's den) and finally, during King Cyrus the Persian's 3rd year reign, Daniel disappeared from written texts. Noted historian Josephus reported that Daniel lived until the time of Artaxerxes the Persian king, after repatriation back to Jerusalem which Cyrus allowed, as prophesied by the Jewish prophet Isaiah (Isa. 44:28; 45:1), some 150 years before Cyrus's time.

2 Samuel 17:8 (Absalom is getting counsel from Hushai) 8 Moreover, Hushai said, "You know your father [David] and his men, that they are mighty men and they are fierce, like a bear robbed of her cubs in the field. And your father is an expert in warfare, and will not spend the night with the people. "like a bear" = mighty men (warriors) □ CR David and his men are likened to a bear Clue: of 2nd Bear King geographic location Rethlehem is in Judah (south of Jerusalem)

What does "raised up on one side" mean? What does Scripture tell us of 'ribs' and 'devour'? For brownie points: Who are "they" in "thus <u>they</u> said to it…"



"raised up on one side"

☆ 'raised up' is 'qum' in Aramic which means to arise, set up, or establish

"raised up on one side"

- c 'chad' corresponds to Hebrew 'had' which the subject is singled out from another
- A This bear was on its side, but the time came when it was made to stand

"three ribs"

'rib' in Aramaic is 'ala'
It corresponds to 'sela' in Hebrew which means rib or side
'sela' is the Hebrew root word used to describe where God created Eve from (Adam's sela or side or rib)
The Bear in Daniel's vision has 3 ribs (ala or sela) in its mouth

'Arise, devour much meat!'

This Bear was given the command to:

- Arise' is an indication that the bear was on its side (a picture of it hibernating) but the time came when it was established
- ☆ 'devour' is the Aramaic verb 'akal' which is often used to describe a beast feasting on its prey
- R It's Hebrew equivalent is also 'akal' which means to eat, consume freely
- Reversion of the America Ameri

(akal' is associated with devouring nations:

Numbers 24:8-9 (Balaam's Oracles) 8 "God brings him [Israel] out of Egypt, He [Messiah] is for him [Israel] like the horns of the wild ox. He [Messiah] will **devour [akal]** the nations who are his [Messiah's] adversaries, And will crush their bones in pieces, And shatter them with his arrows. 9 "He couches, he lies down as a lion, And as a lion, who dares rouse him? Blessed is everyone who blesses you [Israel], And cursed is everyone who curses you [Israel]."

Psalms 52:4 You love all words that devour (akal), O deceitful tongue.

A 'akal' in Num 24 is associated with devouring nations who are adversaries

- We can deduce that the 2nd King in Daniel's vision (the Bear King with 3 ribs in its mouth) is a deceitful king, masterful in war, who were side by side with 3 neighboring nations
- A However the Bear king was given a decree from heaven to to overtake those 3 nations (along with its kings) and prey on them

Is there any OT passages that can tell us more of this 2nd Bear:

Proverbs 28:15 Like a roaring lion and <u>a rushing bear</u>

- Is <u>a wicked ruler</u> over a poor people.
- In context, rab yam (great sea) quite literally means the roaring sea
 Rushing bear = wicked ruler
- ✓ We can deduce that the 2nd Beast (Bear) will be a wicked king like the 1st Beast (Lion)


Who are "they" in:

Daniel 7:5 And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a bear. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth between its teeth; and thus **they** said to it, 'Arise, devour much meat!'

Extra brownie points: How many are they?

Which present day countries are in play where the 2nd beast (2nd wicked king whom he and his men are valiant warriors) will arise from Daniel's four beasts vision (City of David/Bethlehem) and devour 3 nations through deceit.





Now let's add the 2nd king's geographical location using Scripture



The 2nd of 4 kings of Daniels' vision rose from Judah (Southern Israel) where King David was from (Bethlehem, the City of David):
