- 1. What exactly was Jesus' brother's plan for Jesus? What was the goal of "show yourself to the world" (v. 4)?
- 2. In what ways might Christians / Churches pursue the brother's plan today?
- 3. Why does v. 7 say that the "world" hates Jesus?
- 4. Jesus anticipates here only 2 ultimate responses to Him: believe Him or hate Him. So, what's going on with those who neither believe Him nor hate Him (like the first group in v. 12)?
- 5. How would Jesus' example (up to this point in John's Gospel) direct us to interact with ones who have not arrived at either believing or hating?
