I. A Desire for "Fresh Oil"

- Psalm 92:10 I shall be anointed with fresh oil
- A. The anointing with oil was symbolic of two things:
 - 1. It was symbolic of the abundance of God's blessings.
 - Psalm 23:5
 - 2. It was symbolic of the Holy Spirit.
 - I Samuel 16:13
- B. David wanted an anointing of Fresh Oil.
 - Psalm 92:10

Fresh oil starts with:

- II. Having a heart right with God.
 - Isaiah 29:13
 - A. We should avoid hypocrisy.
 - Matthew 15:7-9
 - 1. There are two types of hypocrisy.
 - Job 36:11-13
 - a. Hypocrisy in one's behavior (v. 12)

 But if they obey not
 - b. Hypocrisy in one's heart (v. 13)

 But the hypocrites in heart heap up

 wrath
 - Matthew 23:27-28
 - B. We should have a biblical understanding of our hearts.
 - Matthew 15:18-20

III. How to have a right heart

A. It begins with God's cleansing.

- Psalm 51:10
- 1. The priority of cleansing
 - Matthew 23:25-26
 - David knew if his heart was right, everything else would fall into place.
- 2. The method and measure of cleansing
 - a. The method
 - (1) The blood of Jesus Christ (cleansing of our heart)
 - Revelation 1:5
 - I John 1:6-9
 - (2) The Word of God
 - Psalm 119:9
 - Ephesians 5:25-26
 - b. The measure
 - (1) At every occurrence
 - (2) At least daily

B. It requires our protection.

- Proverbs 4:23-25
- 1. Guard our ears (v. 24)
- 2. Shield your eyes (v. 25)

C. It necessitates a desire.

- 1. God's desire
 - Psalm 51:6, 16-17
- 2. The believer's desire
 - Psalm 19:14
