1. How does the history of the Exodus help us to understand these verses better?
2. What does it mean that God *delights in mercy*? What does that show about the character of God?
3. What does it mean that God *will turn again*? How does that comfort the believer?
4. What does it mean that God *subdues our iniquities*? How does that encourage those who feel overcome by their sins?
5. How can God 'forget' our sins, while He always knows everything perfectly?
6. What did God promise His people in the covenant with Abraham? How can these promises still encourage God's people today?
7. * What does it mean that God casts the sin of every believer in the depths of the sea? What other word pictures do you remember from the sermon that show that God is merciful?

5. * Who was Simon the Pharisee? Did he love the Lord Jesus? Who was the woman? What did she do? How did what she did show her love for the Lord Jesus? How can you show your love for the Lord Jesus?
