## A national individual redemption

Text: Galatians 3:13

- 1. The theme of redemption in the Old Testament
  - a. The Hebrew "Ga-al". It means "redeem" or "to act as a kinsman redeemer." **Exodus 6:6-8**.
  - Kinsman redeemer in a family had an obligation to redeem. Leviticus 25:55 notes that Israel has been redeemed to be God's servants.
  - c. God as kinsman-redeemer Isa 63:16 (Isa 54:5)
- 2. Brought forward to the New Testament
  - a. A new need for redemption Hebrews 9:15. Why do we need to be redeemed from the law?
  - b. We need a kinsman redeemer. My redeemer, Jesus Christ is my only hope.
  - c. We are redeemed to become servants of the Most High God 1 Corinthians 6:18-20.
- 3. The redeemer
  - a. Job, by faith, expressed assurance in the one who would save him 19:25-27.
  - b. Our kinsman redeemer I John 2:1-2, Romans 2:23-25.
  - c. Baby Jessica and us.
