How to Ambush Your Ai: Big Battles with Little Problems Joshua 8:1-35

Facts about the setting:

- Ai: <u>"A heap of ruins"</u>
- Bethel: "The House of God"

Three battles we will always fight:

- An external enemy the world
- An <u>internal</u> enemy <u>flesh (self)</u>
- An infernal enemy the Devil
- 1. Recognize the <u>reasons</u> for your defeat.
 - The <u>nation</u> lost
 - The man lost

Colossians 3:5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

- 2. Remember the results of your defeat (vs. 4-9).
 - 4 D's death, discouragement, distrust, and dishonor
- 3. Reengage the enemy of your defeat (vs. 8:1-2).
- 4. Realize the victory over your defeat.
 - Pursue God's plan: ambush your problems (vs. 3-17)
 - Count on God's power (vs. 18-23)
 - Put a <u>death sentence</u> on your fleshly lust (vs. 27-29)
 - Put a priority on spiritual devotion (vs. 30-35)

Lasting Lesson from Ai: No failure has to be final.
