THE CHARACTERISTICS OF CHRIST'S IMAGE, Pt. 2 (Colossians 3:10-15)

A. MANKIND: BEARERS OF GOD'S IMAGE (Gen. 1:26-28; 5:1; 9:6; Jas. 3:9)

- created in God's image & likeness substantive, relational, moral, functional
- *fall into sin (Gen. 3) image of God is defaced but not erased*
- regeneration (2 Cor. 4:4; 5:17) & restoration (1 Cor. 15:49) through Jesus Christ

B. TRANSFORMED INTO CHRIST'S IMAGE (2 Cor. 3:18; 4:4; 5:17)

- 1. The **people** of this transformation includes all believers "but we all with unveiled face."
- 2. The **process** of this transformation involves on our part "beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord."
- 3. The product or result of this process is that we "are being transformed [metamorphoomai]."
- 4. The picture/pattern of this transformation is "into the same image" of Jesus Christ.
- 5. The **progression** of this transformation is "from glory to glory."
- 6. The **power** to accomplish this supernatural transformation is "by the Spirit of the Lord."

C. CHARACTERISTICS OF CHRIST'S IMAGE (Col. 3:10-15)

- 1 If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.
- 2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.
- 3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
- 4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.
- 5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.
- 6 Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience,
- 7 in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.
- 8 But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.
- 9 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,
- 10 and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the **<u>image of Him</u>** who created him,
- 11 where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free, but Christ is all and in all.
- 12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on **tender mercies**, **kindness**, **humility**, **meekness**, **longsuffering**;
- 13 **bearing** with one another, and **forgiving** one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.
- 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.
- 15 And let the **peace** of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be **thankful**.
