Historical Context: 2 Samuel 15:10-17

Inscription: A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.

Poetical Layout

- 1) Lord, How are they increased that trouble me! Many are they that rise up against me.
- Many there be which say of my soul,
 There is no help for him in God. Selah.
- 3) But thou, O Lord, art a shield for me;
 My glory, and the lifter up of mine head.
- 4) I cried unto the Lord with my voice,
 And he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.
- I laid me down and slept;
 I awaked; for the Lord sustained me.
- 6) I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people,

 That have set themselves against me round about.
- 7) Arise, O Lord; save me, O my God: For thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek bone; Thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.
- 8) Salvation belongeth unto the Lord:
 Thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.

- 4. How does the language of salvation and deliverance in this psalm resonate with our understanding of God's redemptive work in our lives?
- 5. What does it mean to have God as our "shield" and the "lifter of our head," and how does this impact our outlook on life's challenges?
- 6. How can we maintain a posture of trust and confidence in God, even when surrounded by adversity?
- 7. How does David's declaration of God's blessings and victory over his enemies inspire us to trust in God's sovereignty and power?
